NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Belle Plaine, Minnesota (the "City") will meet on Monday, September 21, 2020, at or after 6:30 p.m., in the council chambers at City Hall, 218 North Meridian Street in the City, to hold a public hearing concerning (1) the adoption of a five-year capital improvement plan for the City prepared in compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.521, as amended (the "Plan"); and (2) the issuance of general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") to finance capital projects described in the Plan, including the acquisition of certain property in the City and the public works facility located thereon from the Belle Plaine Economic Development Authority (the "Authority") through the redemption and prepayment of the Public Project Revenue Bonds, Series 2012A (City of Belle Plaine, Minnesota Lease with Option to Purchase Agreement), issued by the Authority on February 1, 2012. The maximum principal amount of the Bonds to be issued under the Plan is \$910,000.

If a petition requesting a vote on the issuance of the Bonds signed by voters equal to five percent of the votes cast in the City in the last municipal general election is filed with the City Administrator within 30 days after the public hearing, the City may issue the Bonds only after obtaining approval of a majority of voters voting on the question at an election.

A copy of the Plan is available for inspection in the City Administrator's office at City Hall. All interested persons may appear and be heard at the public hearing either orally or in writing or may file written comments with the City Administrator before the hearing.
